



Human Trafficking Indicators

Housekeeping



- “Do not Disturb” sign used constantly
- Excessive amounts of cash in room
- Multiple computers, cell phones & other technology
- Alcohol or illegal drugs in rooms.
- Refusal of cleaning services
- Leaving room infrequently, not at all or at odd hours
- Hanging out in the hallways
- Asking for extra towels
- Minors left alone in room
- Excessive # of people in room
- Provocative clothing & shoes
- Constant flow of men at all hours
- Sex paraphernalia in rooms (condom wrappers, lube etc)
- Extended stay with few or no possessions
- Men waiting in lobby or outside of the room.
- Female patrons taking a lot of toiletries.

Please keep in mind that the presence of just one of these indicators does not immediately mean that human trafficking is occurring.
