## Fatality/Injury Counts and Rates

<b>LTI:</b>	Count of Allowed LTIs with an accident date occurring in the year indicated.
<b>NLTI:</b>	Count of Allowed NLTIs with an accident date occurring in the year indicated.
<b>LTI Rate:</b>	(Total number of Allowed LTIs / Derived Hours Worked) x 200,000.
<b>NLTI Rate:</b>	(Total number of Allowed NLTIs / Derived Hours Worked) x 200,000.
<b>Total Rate:</b>	The sum of the LTI Rate and NLTI Rate.

## Premiums/Worker Counts and Insurable Earnings

<b>Premium Amount:</b>	Total Premiums for the firms included in the Rate Group Profile. Premium is the amount that the employer is obligated to pay for the year, based on Insurable Earnings times the firm's Individual Premium Rate divided by 100.
<b>FTE Workers:</b>	Total FTE Workers for the firms included in the Rate Group Profile. <b>Full Time Equivalent</b> workers is an estimate based on the average hourly wage for the rate group and the insurable earnings for the calendar year, assuming a person works an average of 2,000 hours per year.
<b>Derived Hours Worked:</b>	Total Derived Hours Worked for the firms included in the Rate Group Profile. Derived Hours Worked is an estimated number based on the insurable earnings divided by the average hourly wage for the firm's rate group(s).
<b>Insurable Earnings:</b>	Total Insurable Earnings for the firms included in the Rate Group Profile. The amount of earnings paid to workers that are covered by WSIB insurance for a given year and which are subject to premium payments.

## Days Lost

<b>Incident Year:</b>	The number of days lost in the calendar year for Allowed LTIs with an accident date in the calendar year indicated.
<b>Award Year:</b>	The number of days lost awarded in the calendar year for Allowed LTIs regardless of accident date.

## Critical Injury

The count of Allowed Serious Injuries with an accident date in the calendar year indicated. These Injuries are based on the Critical Injury Indicator in EIW and includes the following: *Places Life in Jeopardy (Traumatic injuries to spinal cord, Multiple traumatic injuries, Gunshot wounds, Drowning, Electrocution, Internal injuries to organs, Other poisonings and toxic effects, Animal or insect bites) , Fracture of a Leg or Arm but not a Finger or Toe (excludes wrist and ankle), Amputation of a Leg, Arm, Hand or Foot but not a Finger or Toe, Produces Unconsciousness (Concussions, Cerebral Haemorrhages, Intracranial injuries), The Loss of Sight in an Eye (Blindness, Enucleations), Burns to a Major Portion of the Body (First-degree burns and multiple burns).*

## Claim Breakdown By FTE Bands

<b>Firm Count:</b>	The count of firms by Employer Size Group for the calendar year indicated. Employer size is based on the number of FTE for the Employer in that year.
<b>Total FTE:</b>	Total FTE for firms in that Employer Size Group for the year indicated.
<b>LTI:</b>	Total LTI for firms in that Employer Size Group for the year indicated.
<b>NLTI:</b>	Total NLTI for firms in that Employer Size Group for the year indicated.

## LTI Breakdown by New Worker

The Count of Allowed LTIs by New Worker for LTIs with an accident date in the calendar year indicated.
